Ladybird International Arts offered over the last week, four international digital candidates for the ABRSM tertiary level performance exams, called Associate of Music. This is the level prior to the Diploma and Licentiate. The happy results are out, with pianist Katleho Mothae achieving one of the top scores in South Africa with 92%. Daniël Bezuidenhout — who is doing music for leisure, is a full-time teacher at the Ladybrand High School and the Ladybird Head of Dramatic Arts — achieved a merit rating with 80% for his piano recital. Robert Crowther, well-known in Ladybrand as pharmacist, and Rorisang Ntsasa, a music teacher in Maseru, are two solo-singers, both passed this high grade. Galen Green, a clarinet grade 7 and the Ladybird Music Student of the Year, achieved a distinction.

Both Katleho Mothae and Galen Green, along with Euníze Crous – who achieved a top score for flute grade 7 earlier in the year – have been selected to participate in the ABRSM High Scorer's Concert in Bloemfontein on 21 November.

She shared that she is in the process of retiring to her 'home-country', England, and packing up for the big move back to the Northern Hemisphere and came upon some items the arts could maybe find use for.



With a friendly smile she offered three booklets as gifts. Two very small red ones. Old and well-read by the look of the covers. She also gifted us a small, brown leather booklet. Oblong with the title, Autographs, on the front page. This booklet was clearly a well-loved item judged by the worn and velvet softness of the muchhandled leather cover.

After greeting her and wishing her a blessed journey and happy retirement, I returned to my studio and put the books on the shelf in my studio and continued with the class. And promptly forgot all about the gifted books...

Many years later, at the end of 2020, when we were planning the 2021 Ladybird events I, somehow, noticed that a brown shabby booklet is always in my way when taking books from my bookshelf, as it was laying on top. Not snuck in like books usually are. I thought, let me open this, before I chuck it away to see what is inside.

Behold, it was a treasure of messages, pictures, poems, concert programmes with autographs of some very famous people. Benjamin Britten, John Ireland, Juliard Quartet, conductors, singers, pianists, and

many more.

The most astonishing fact was the dates these autographs were signed - 1943 to 1948. A treasure trove of 'upliftment' gathered by Rita from the times just before and after World War II.

We there-and then, decided to title this year's final concert, Autographs. Tonight, we dedicate to Rita - whom we got to know through her precious gift to us - and all the artists, whose humble function are to uplift humanity in times of peril.

Wishing you both the very best for the future.














### Aspiring young designers

Pinkie Thulo and Ntathi Petersen are two young artists who are working hard toward developing distinctive styles for their graphic designs under the direction of Belinda Pike.






