



# Young designers of note

Belinda Pike - Ladybird Graphic Design

The Ladybird Visual Art Department offers two graphic design courses: The first year in manual design and a second year digital. Three students are doing the first year Ladybird Graphic Design Certificate course this year. They are Letsosa Letsosa (22), Keletso Tlali (19) and Patricia Tsoloane (23). These young and aspiring designers, from diverse arts backgrounds, all have in common their talent and passion for design.

#### PRODUCT DRAFTING & PACKAGING

**Letsosa Letsosa** is a student in Architecture at Limkokwing University of Creative Technology in Lesotho. He is also doing the Ladybird Graphic Design Course and currently endorsing in the design of three-dimensional product drafting and packaging. This product designing project, is a give-away item, meant as promotion for his business, *EDesign*. He is designing a set of two bracelets and shoe tags, to offer as free prototypes of his work to his clients. Throughout this process students learn about product design, promotional material, packaging and using packaging as an advertising tool. Both these items include imaging and typography, and students should aim carefully and consciously to combine these elements in such a manner, that it forms an effective and aesthetically pleasing outcome, always minding the basic principles of design.

#### **GIFT WRAPPING**

**Keletso Tlali** is doing designs for gift wrapping, utilizing repeated patterns. For this project students can gather inspiration from any source, Keletso choose nature as topic. Students make use of deletion to create a simplified illustration, which they then repeat on an appropriate surface. This process is then repeated in various colour-schemes. Throughout this project students learn about the *gestalt*-principles of simplification and deletion, printing techniques and colour-schemes.

#### **STATIONERY & CORPORATE IDENTITY**

**Patricia Tsoloane**, is currently busy designing business stationery for her business, *FaFa Fashion*. This project goes hand in hand with Corporate Identity or logo design. Students are encouraged to create designs suitable to represent the ethos of their own or a chosen business, product or service. This comprises of a business card, letterhead and envelope. The syllabus for the Ladybird Graphic Design course, includes studying the basic advertising tools, i.e. business stationery, layout and using a corporate identity on various applications.

## Behold, a new rising star!

A *nova* rising from the mountain kingdom of Lesotho is the young and upcoming soul singer-songwriter, **Leomile Motsetsela**. Her performances are a musical tapestry, in Sesotho and English, aiming to portray and discuss relevant issues on identity and womanhood. Her deliberation of these important, but often obscured aspects of African life and humanity, exposé as golden threads of honesty, idealism and hope in her songs.

She featured for the first time at the *National Arts Festival*, Grahamstown, *Standard Bank Joy of Jazz* in 2016. After which she became a regular constituent within the Johannesburg music scene, with performances at

the *Basha Uhuru* music festival, *Soweto Arts and Craft Fair* and *Heart 2 Art* at the Johannesburg Theatre, the coveted *Fétè de la Musique* and many more. *Pula Molomo*, is her début album, launched in her hometown of Maseru, Lesotho, and at the iconic jazz venue, *Bassline*, in Newtown, Johannesburg during 2016.

Leomile has shared the stage with the African music legend, Tshepo Tshola, who has subsequently taken her under his wing as mentor. In 2017 she showcased her music alongside *Village Pope* at the *Joy of Jazz* and *Macufe* festivals. She featured in the SABC1 series, *Brothers and Sisters*, a documentary on *SOUL*, in 2017.

She is a loved-favourite in her home country, performing as a headliner at many local events, i.e. the *Maletsunyane Braai Festival* and *Meat and Beer Festival*. She has had the privilege of performing at the Fifty Years Anniversary event of the *Metropolitan* magazine, in the presence of his Majesty King Letsie III and Queen Mamohato of Lesotho.

She is currently enrolled as a student in Solo-singing, Piano and Music Theory at the Ladybird International Arts Academy with the aim of expanding her professional and academic visions in music. It is undeniable that Leomile is supremely talented and an exciting new rising star on the global music horizon.



# Simply Plakatstil

Plakatstil (German for "poster style"), also known as Sachplakat, was an early style of poster art that originated in Germany in the 1900s, started by Lucian Bernhard in Berlin. The common characteristics of this style are bold eye-catching lettering with flat colours, simplified shapes and objects and the composition focuses on a central object.


For a poster competition sponsored by *Preister* matches,

Bernhard took the

novel approach of drawing two large matches and writing the brand name above them in clean, bold letters. *Plakatstil* turned away from the complexity of *Art Nouveau* and propagated a more modern outlook on simplicity of poster art.
