


Spring Art Workshop 7 Sep

The 'Art & Craft' of Practicing Effectively

Are you practicing to the best of your ability? Is it a challenge to stay focused? Worry not, a teacher and concert pianist Kathryn Page has the best remedy to enhance your practice time.

It can be an exciting, energizing and inspirational moments on an instrument during the earlier stages of learning new repertoire, with fresh pieces bringing a sense of purpose. Our new challenges at our instruments energize our practicing, giving us a sense of flow, boundless enthusiasm and a real sense of discovery. We are aboard the 'good ship', the 'pianoforte' sailing forth, discovering and conquering the 'new territories' from our incredible repertoire. Yet it can be dispiriting to note how quickly this enthusiasm can wane. Perhaps we stumble across a particularly fast recording on YouTube of the music we're struggling through. We can feel frustrated over nasty corners in pieces that seem to present insurmountable challenges, or we simply lose the desire to work on music that has become almost too familiar. How can we maintain our focus, nurture and develop our motivation whilst practicing? How can we work to our optimum, remain consistently focused and develop our love of the music we have chosen to study a highest level possible?

Organising, planning and scheduling are of vital importance for successful practicing – both for the long term and the immediate future.

The 5 Top Tips on how to practice

- 1. Have a vision. Always have a goal, aim and ambition.
- 2. Plan. Organize and schedule your time at your instrument carefully. Review this regularly.
- 3. Good practice can sound unpleasant. Always emphasize the difference between practicing and playing your repertoire.
- 4. Be a musical scientist. View practicing as experimentation.
- 5. Calmness is the word. Be patient, take time and never get discouraged.






