She has authored, co-authored, edited numerous textbooks, study guides, exemplar papers and Elearning programmes in the fields of the Natural Sciences, Life Sciences and the Arts. She is currently working on developing

Helen has also scripted educational television lessons (for Ethiopian educational television) and on SABC1 for *Geleza Nathi*, *Mindset* and *Studymate*, and is the author of the *Vodaschool for Life* Sciences, Natural Sciences and Social Sciences.




















Fun End














Congratulations to our Head of Visual Arts, Nika with her marriage to Riaan Meintjies on 18 November. We wish you many happy years together!
